The comment of a young fellow "It is best and first in the world", said it all. This inaugural event was a hoot amongst Kids, parents and attendees espousing sincere admiration from every-body there.

**Snack & Chat "S&C" monthly Sessions:** Proudly bringing communities together enhancing inclusivity, cohesion and harmony all around; and yes, yummy snacks, tea & coffee is regarded as added bonus.
